Skilling Initiative for SAUBHAGYA Project Launched

Hon'ble Minister of Petroleum & Natural Gas and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Shri Dharmendra Pradhan and Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) Power Shri Raj Kumar Singh, jointly launched skilling initiative under Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana (SAUBHAGYA) through video conferencing at six states i.e. Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Uttar Pradesh on 27.3.2018. The Initiative is aimed at skill training and certification of over 50000 workforce across the country, enabling them to successfully implement SAUBHAGYA Scheme. It may be recalled that SAUBHAGYA Scheme is designed to ensure achievement of the goal of Universal Households Electrification providing last miles connectivity and access to electricity to 4 crore plus household in rural and urban areas. The said skilling initiative will be funded by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY).

Speaking on this occasion Minister, Petroleum & Natural Gas and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Shri Dharmendra Pradhan emphasized the need for skilling the **SAUBHAGYA** workforce in Power Sector to improve quality of output, efficiency and safety at workplace. He also thanked Ministry of Power for enabling the initiative.

Shri Raj Kumar Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State for Power (I/C), in his address on the occasion outlined the significance of SAUBHAGYA Scheme and the Skilling Initiative, which will ensure quality of workmanship and proper implementation of the project.

He further stated that beyond SAUBHAGYA, other schemes such as **Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojna (DDUGJY)** and **Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS)** etc. would also required a large workforce, thereby offering significant employment opportunities. This workforce would also need to be adequately trained to ensure smooth implementation of these mega initiatives of Government.

The initiative was launched across SIX states of Assam (Guwahati), Bihar (Patna), Jharkhand (Ranchi), Madhya Pradesh (Bhopal), Odisha(Bhubaneshwar) and Uttar Pradesh (Varanasi). The Hon'ble Ministers interacted with the dignitaries and Senior Officers of State Power Utilities present at various locations and underscored the significance of the proposed skilling initiative. The dignitaries and Officers from these locations assured necessary support towards successful roll out of both SAUBHAGYA and Skilling Initiative.
