

SKILLING INITIATIVE FOR SAUBHAGYA PROJECT LAUNCHED



Opening of Saubhagya Training Programme at Muzaffarpur Bihar

Power Sector Skill Council launched skilling initiative under **Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojna (SAUBHAGYA)** scheme which is aimed at facilitating successful and smooth roll out of Saubhagya scheme, designed to achieve universal household electrification. First pilot batch under Saubhagya was launched at Muzaffarpur Bihar, on 10th Jan 2018 under North Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited (NBPDC).

It may be mentioned that Government of India has launched this scheme, titled- **Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojna (SAUBHAGYA)** with a view to achieve **Universal Household Electrification** by providing last mile connectivity to all households in rural and urban areas through financial assistance to Power Distribution Companies. There are 404.06 lakhs un-electrified households in the country, of which over 343 lakhs are in the six major states e.g. **Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha & Uttar Pradesh**. In these six states there are 200 districts classified in terms of least electrified, these will be the prime locations for electrification project as also for skilling initiative.

Power Sector Skill Council in collaboration with M/s Le-Grand, a French multinational company in the business of complete Electrical solutions, launched skill training programme to Train 2000 Existing Electricians in RPL mode. The programme which is supported under CSR initiative of M/s Le-Grand is being delivered at 15 smart city locations as selected by M/s Le-Grand in consultation with PSSC. The National Occupation Standards, Course Content, Model Curriculum and Training Delivery Plan have been developed by PSSC. The training has on the Job component in addition to class room training. The Delivery of programme is through credible training providers at chosen locations.

The project focuses on enabling large no of practising electricians to take up industry relevant skill training which will help them improve their skills substantially and will thus enable them secure better livelihood and obtain a formal recognition. The project also focuses on gender inclusion by including women electricians.
